

## Alternative Responsibilities for Disable or Handicapped CBJs to Fulfill Master CBJ Requirements

### Cook with a Team:

- 1.) Work with a Team that does not cook in RV/Cook Trailer situation, i.e. pop-up tent or smaller smokers.
- 2.) Attend Cook's Meeting.
- 3.) Do or assist with boxes – garnish, etc. that can be done while sitting down.
- 4.) Sit & learn the cooking process, observe, talk to team throughout and learn techniques, time line, etc. from the team.
- 5.) Attend Awards Ceremony with selected Team.
- 6.) Other tasks as mutually agreed upon by CBJ and Cook.

### Volunteer Assignment:

- 1.) CBJs using assistive devices (cane, walker, crutches, or wheelchair) can assist at turn-in -table, greeting teams or work at leftover table, disposing of garnish as boxes are handed to them.
- 2.) Number changing at smaller contests.
- 3.) Assist Reps in checking in Judges.
- 4.) When appropriate, assist Reps in collating and stapling copies of results or organizing and stapling comment cards, etc. for Awards Ceremony.
