What is a One-Meat contest?

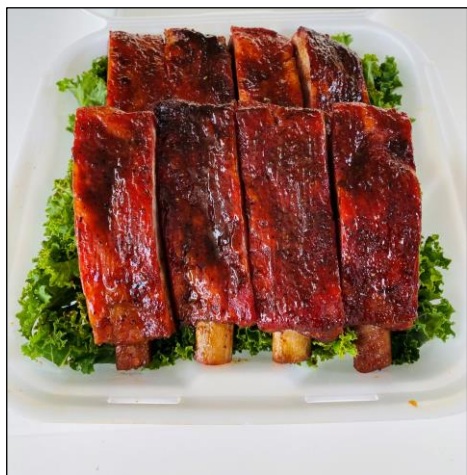
- Only one meat is cooked, following KCBS Master Series rules.
- Any of the four main KCBS meats may be used (Chicken, Pork Ribs, Pork, Brisket).

Why should I hold this type of contest?

- It may be added to an existing contest as a fun event for the day prior to main contest.
- Hold a stand-alone contest.
- Create a series of multiple One-Meat contests over a season.
- KCBS Master Series cook teams earn Team of the Year points for the category; providing incentive for pitmasters to choose specific contests for extra ToY points.
- Great opportunity to invite less experienced cooks to try competing!
