These tax-deductible donations provide scholarships for the post-secondary education of children of KCBS members. There are two options available and we can work with the family and/or friends of the departed to help determine the best fit.

**GENERAL FUND**: The first option is a general fund donation to fuel the entire scholarship and community outreach program. Since 2015, the KCBS Foundation has awarded 180+ individual scholarships. Donating a memorial gift ensures the work of the KCBS Foundation continues, helping educate the next generation of our greater BBQ family.

**NAMED SCHOLARSHIP**: The second option of memorial giving is establishing a named scholarship. With this option, a dedicated scholarship is established in your loved one's name. We can incorporate any specific qualities you would like us to look for among applicants and include you in the selection process. KCBS will create a custom e-flyer to help spread the word about honoring the memory of your loved one with a gift to the KCBS Foundation. The flyer incorporates pictures, cherished memories, and the wishes of the family to honor their loved one through the act of giving.
