

About Our Members

KCBS members are highly engaged and have significant buying power

Education, Employment, Income, Family

- 55% of KCBS members have a bachelor's degree or higher
- 87% own their own home
- 70% are employed full time
 - 30% of members own a business
- 76% of members earn above the United States median household income of \$62k
 - 28% of members earn over \$150,000/year
- Over 99% own at least one vehicle
 - 43% own three or more vehicles
- 84% are married
- 75% have children

Engagement

- 40% of KCBS members participate in 3-10 KCBS-sanctioned events per year
 - 15% participating over 11 times
- Nearly a quarter have paid for Lifetime Membership
- 85% own two or more smokers/grills
 - 43% owning four or more
- 30% use their grill ten or more times per month
- Over half use their smoker nearly weekly
- Nearly ¾ do not belong or participate with any other BBQ or grilling organization
 - KCBS is the way to reach these enthusiasts

Master & Backyard Series

Competition for elite barbeque teams and skilled amateur cooks

Master Series Contests

- Most popular type of contest sanctioned by KCBS
- Teams required to cook all 4 meats (Chicken, Pork Ribs, Pork, and Brisket)
 - Exception: One Meat contests, where Master Series teams can earn Team of the Year points if Chicken, Ribs, Pork, or Brisket are cooked & KCBS rules are used
- Cooking source: wood, wood pellets, or charcoal




Backyard Series Contests

- Non-professional teams who like to smoke/grill
- Promote barbeque in smaller locations & events
- Typically chicken & pork ribs; sometimes pork
- Can be stand-alone contests or added to Master Series
- Cooking source: wood, wood pellets, or charcoal

KCBS Team of the Year program drives fierce competition all season long

Program overview:

- Pitmasters compete in year-long points chase to win coveted title of "KCBS Team of the Year World Champion"
- Overall champion and individual meat champions in Chicken, Pork Ribs, Pork, and Brisket for Master Series
- Backyard Team of the Year points chase for Chicken and Rib categories
- International regions recognize championship pitmasters globally
- Significant bragging rights to drive awareness of pitmasters, restaurants, and brand partners





Program Details

A year-round program to identify the top-performing pitmasters in the world

How it works:

- The 2021 KCBS Team of the Year season is from November 1, 2020 through October 31, 2021
- KCBS-member pitmasters earn points in every KCBS-sanctioned barbeque contest.
- Points accumulate throughout the year based on how the team ranks in the specific individual meat categories they cook.
 - Master Series: Chicken, Ribs, Pork, Brisket, and Overall
 - Backyard Series: Chicken and Ribs
- Extra points are given based on the size of the contest.
- Team of the Year prizes are awarded at the KCBS Annual Banquet; with prize money, trophies and significant exposure going to the top teams.

Master Series

Elite teams cooking all four main meat categories

Master Series:

- Master Series teams across the U.S. and globally can win in each of the four main meat categories Chicken, Ribs, Pork and Brisket plus Overall.
- Ultimately, one KCBS-member barbeque cook team will be crowned the KCBS Team of the Year World Champion.
- In the Master Series Team of the Year program, a cook team's highest 10 scores count within each meat category and overall.
- For Master Series teams who don't cook as many contests throughout the Team of the Year season, KCBS also provides Team of the Year recognition to the top team who cooks a smaller number of contests.
 - Awards are based on Overall score of those competing in 5 or fewer contests, 6-10, 11-15, and 16-20 contests.

2021 Launch of Master Series Chases



Three new ways for Master Series teams to compete and win in 2021

Master Series "Chases"

- Beginning at the launch of the 2021 KCBS Team of the Year season on November 1, 2020, there are three new "Chases" added within the Master Series.
- These new KCBS Master Series Chases will run alongside the annual KCBS Master Series Team of the Year program to create more opportunity for teams to compete and compete on a similar level.
- Chases were based on time periods with relatively equivalent numbers of contests in a typical year.
 - KCBS Master Series Chase 1: November 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021
 - KCBS Master Series Chase 2: May 1, 2021 to July 31, 2021
 - KCBS Master Series Chase 3: August 1, 2021 to October 31, 2021





International Recognition within Master Series

TEAM #YEAR

Special recognition for international teams in specific regions

International Regions:

- The KCBS Team of the Year awards program also recognizes the top pitmasters internationally, with Canadian, European, and Australian divisions.
- Canadian and European teams keep their top 5 highest scores and Australian cook teams keep their top 3 highest scores.
- Note: Any Master Series team can compete in the Team of the Year program, regardless of location. The international categories are simply a way of providing extra recognition to top teams outside the USA.



Backyard Series

Talented amateurs who have made the jump from the cul-de-sac to the competition circuit

Backyard Series:

- Based on the growth and excitement among Backyard barbeque cook teams, the Kansas City Barbeque Society developed a Backyard Series Team of the Year program that launched in 2020.
- KCBS-Member Backyard Series teams can be crowned KCBS Backyard Team of the Year in both the Chicken and Pork Ribs categories.
- A KCBS Backyard team's top highest 5 scores in Chicken and Ribs count for Team of the Year points.







Master Series Chases – The Details

Master Series teams can earn points and be recognized throughout the year

Master Series "Chases"

- Within each Chase, prizes will be awarded to the top ten teams in the Master Series in each of the four main meat categories (Chicken, Ribs, Pork, Brisket) and Overall.
- Points will accumulate in the same way as they do for the annual KCBS Team of the Year program, but only the <u>top five scores</u> within each KCBS Master Series Chase count for that chase's prize pool.
- The annual KCBS Team of Year World Champion title will still count a Master Series team's top 10 scores throughout the entire 2021 barbeque Team of the Year season.



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KANSAS CITY, MO. – The Kansas City Barbeque Society (KCBS) recently crowned the winners of its two largest barbecue competitions: the KCBS World Invitational and the KCBS Team of the Year points winners.

The KCBS World Invitational, presented by Smithfield Foods, held its annual head-to-head barbecue pitmasters competition at the Prairle Band Casino & Resort in Mayetta, Kan., on Nov. 13-14. This year's event was an invitation of champions and qualifiers from the Master Series division pitmasters. Contestants needed to be a Grand Champion or Reserve Grand Champion at a KCBS-sanctioned barbecue contest between Jan. 1, 2019, and July 31, 2020.
